There is a grant available through the DOT for traffic safety improvements that could potentially fully fund a vehicle detection camera to control the intersection of Highway 175 & Moorehead Avenue with no match or cost from the City. Motion by Tomlinson to approve Resolution 2018-22 a resolution authorizing the submittal of an application with the lowa Department of Transportation for traffic safety improvement program (TSIP) funding for the intersection of US Highway 175 and Moorehead Avenue to replace inductive-loop traffic detectors with a vehicle detection camera, second by Clough. On a unanimous vote, motion carried. The City expects to hear a determination on the grant application January, 2019.

Motion by Ernst to adjourn, second by Clough. On a unanimous vote, motion carried.
